LEDGESTONE	The look of split layered stone with long dimensional pieces. The narrower style gives the edge a pronounced rock cleavage look.	Installed in a stacked design with no joint. OCALA	Pieces were molded from actual Florida Coral Rocks.	Random installed with even sized joints.	420	2" to 3"	6" to 10"	6" to 10"	3/4"
OHIO LIMESTONE	Predominantly squared & rectangular pieces with a chiseled face design.	Installed in a coursed pattern with long side down and level.	330	1 1/2" to 2"	2" to 8"	4" to 18"	3/4"

RUSTIC	Combination of Rubble and Stack Stone Patterns. See Stack Patterns for Texture Details.	Customer determines the percentage of mix. A 50% to 50% mix may be laid with or without a joint.
